This is not just for the riders, wouldn't it be great to see as many people as possible (men, women and kids) over the weekend support this wonderful cause.

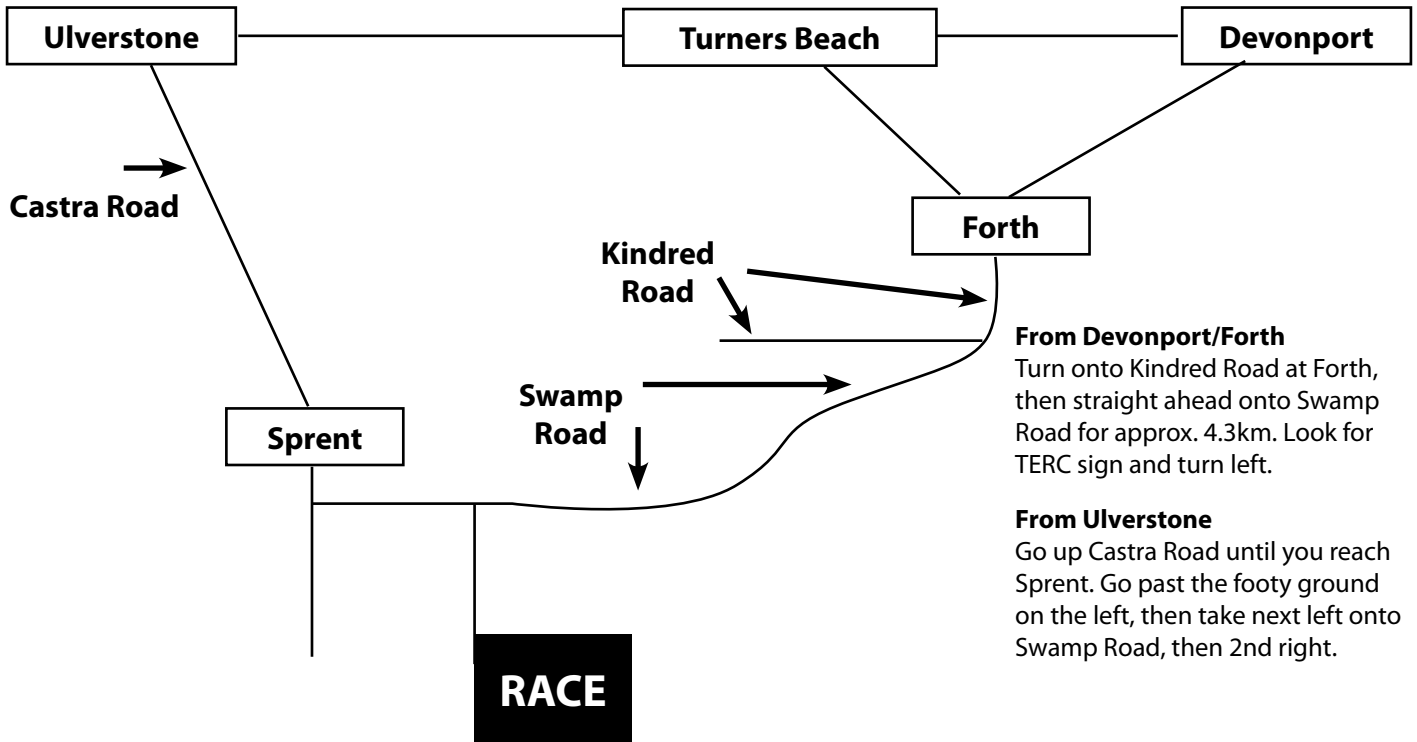
