Any transponder issues need to be claimed and reported through contacting MY Laps direct.

Other than that the club is looking at investing in a large countdown timer for the riders to see during our enduro events. We're looking at a few versions at the moment to suit our outdoor needs so hopefully we will have something up and running shortly!! So Stay Tuned!!!!

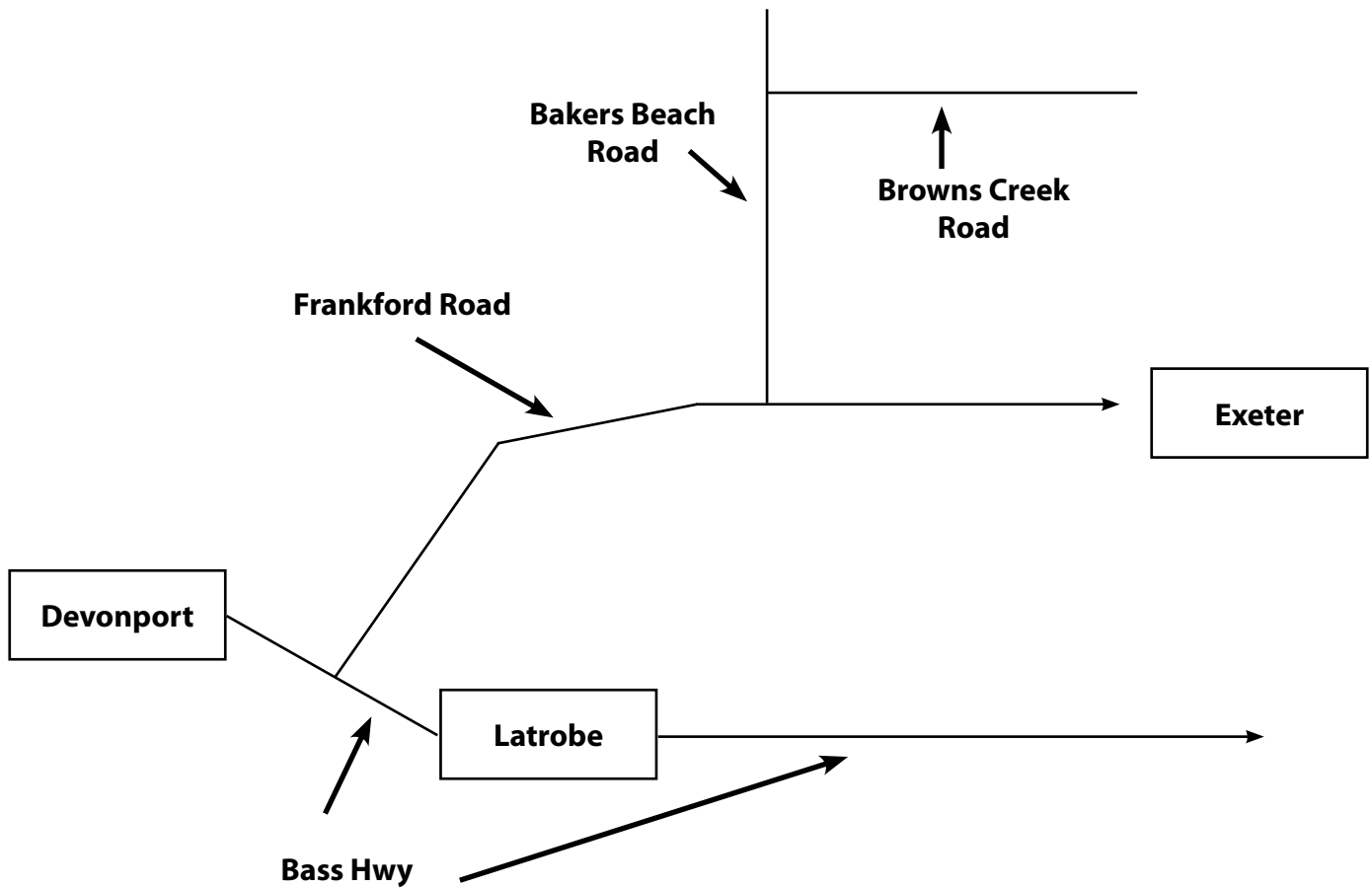
This is not just for the riders, wouldn't it be great to see as many people as possible (men, women and kids) over the weekend support this wonderful cause.
