TERC COMMITTEE 2011

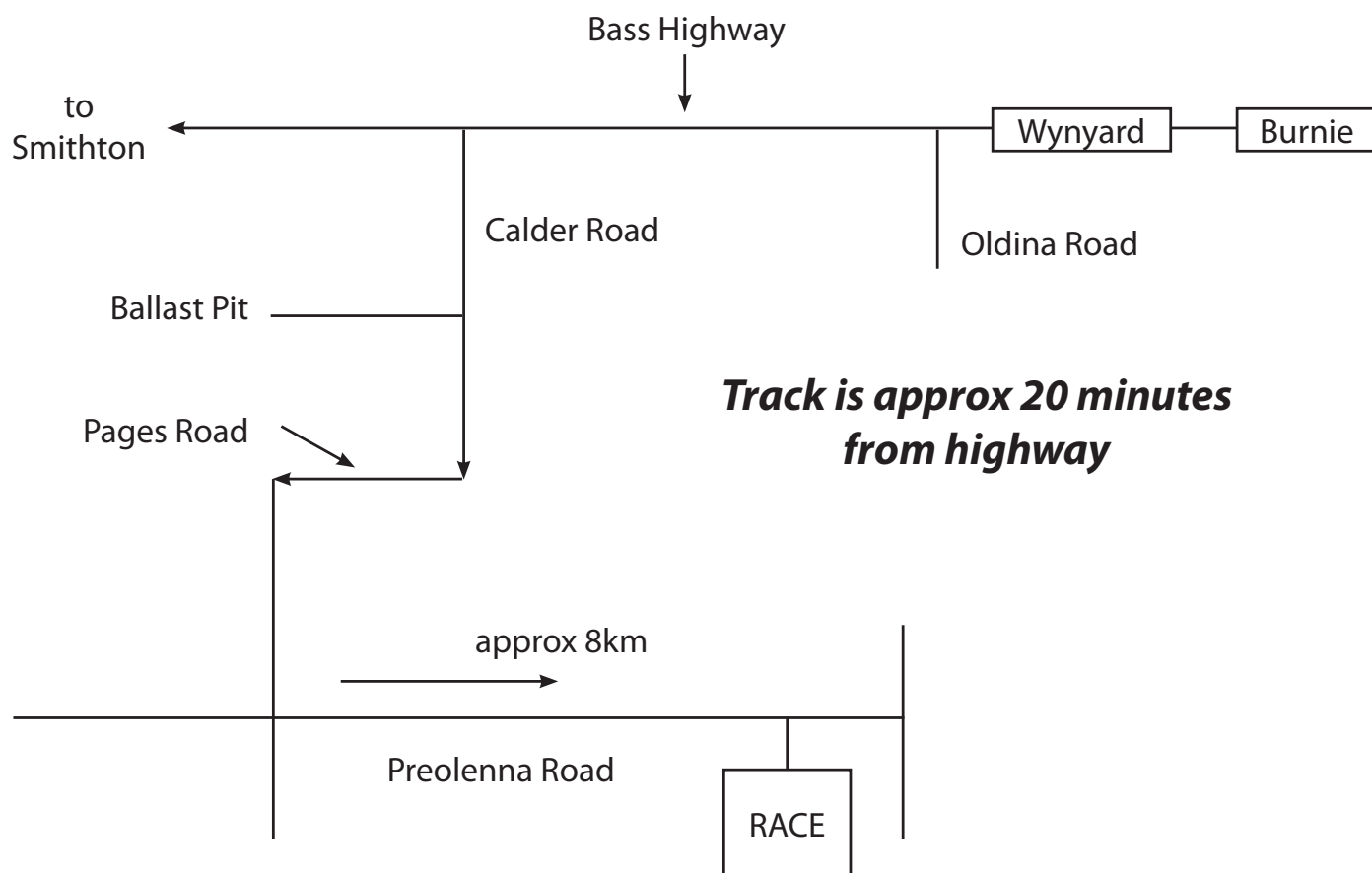
All committee positions will be vacant at the AGM early next year. If you feel you can contribute, consider a position on the committee. Have a direct input into the way the club is run.
