Hi to all our members,

What a tough couple of months it has been for us all. I can't ever remember in the 30 odd years I have been around our club having to cancel races and reschedule so many events in our race calendar, we are as frustrated as you are. Sitting here and thinking about all of this makes me reflect on what we use to do back in the day, but now it is 2016 and we have obligations, not only to you but to all our land owners as well, we just can't leave all the land degradation that we use to.



We have had a meeting with Forestry Tasmania this week which was very positive and we learnt a lot, like where we can ride and what obligations we have to keep Forestry happy with what we do; we just can't turn up to race, leave a mess and expect to come back next week. For example: Forestry get a government audit on the lands they control, their criteria are that ruts should not exceed 250mm deep, (think about that for a minute, they know that is tough for us and will cut a bit of slack but we still need to keep this in mind), they also do not like the muddy water from our tracks running to the waterways. They have safety concerns about all the rain we have had this year which leaves the ground so wet that trees can blow over or cause landslides, these are just some of the things we are dealing with. Bakers Beach is not over the line just yet so let's hope we get a break in the weather cycle soon. I think it will be okay because the ground is a lot different and it will hold up better.

We have a band of fantastic track builders who have been building tracks twice, repairing bridges 2 and 3 times and then being told to go and pull them down. Quite frankly they are totally over the whole thing, we are trying to get things back on track and the last half of the race calendar will change to adjust to fit in more events, so you will need to keep an eye on the web site for more details. Ashlea has just been so amazing with all the extra work she has been doing with permits and trying to get all the paper work sorted out, I don't know how she finds the time, so when you see here please say thanks as without her work we could not race. To my committee I would like to say a very big thanks as it has been tough but we are all in this together. To our club members I would ask that when we call for track builders you would all come and help out as we are going to run back to back events for the rest of the year, it is going to be very hard to get all the work done so I would like you all to be hands on and help make it happen as without you we will find this almost impossible. Remember it is your club and we want you to be part of the process going forward. I will keep you all in the loop, we will know more at the next committee meeting so please watch this space.

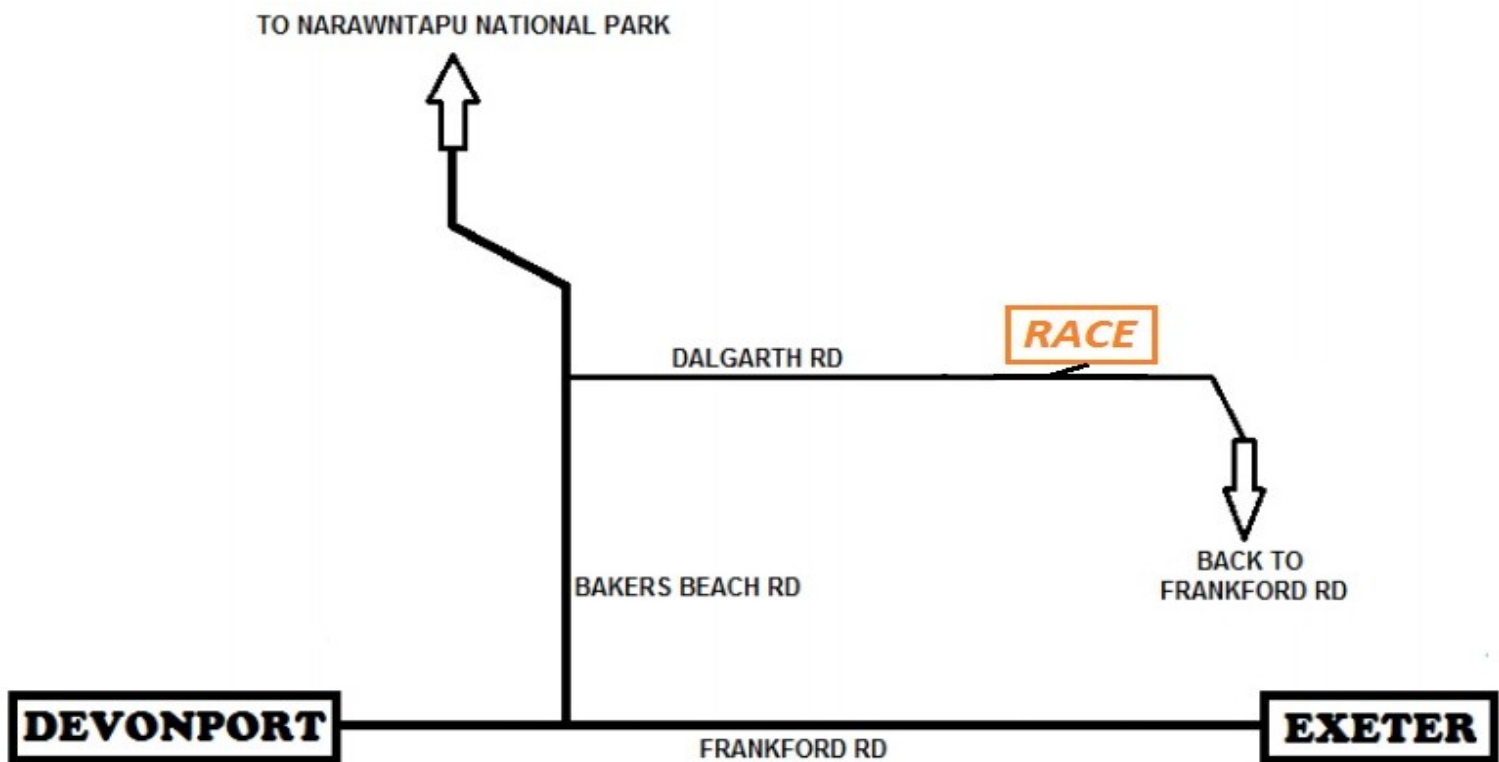
Committee Meetings
