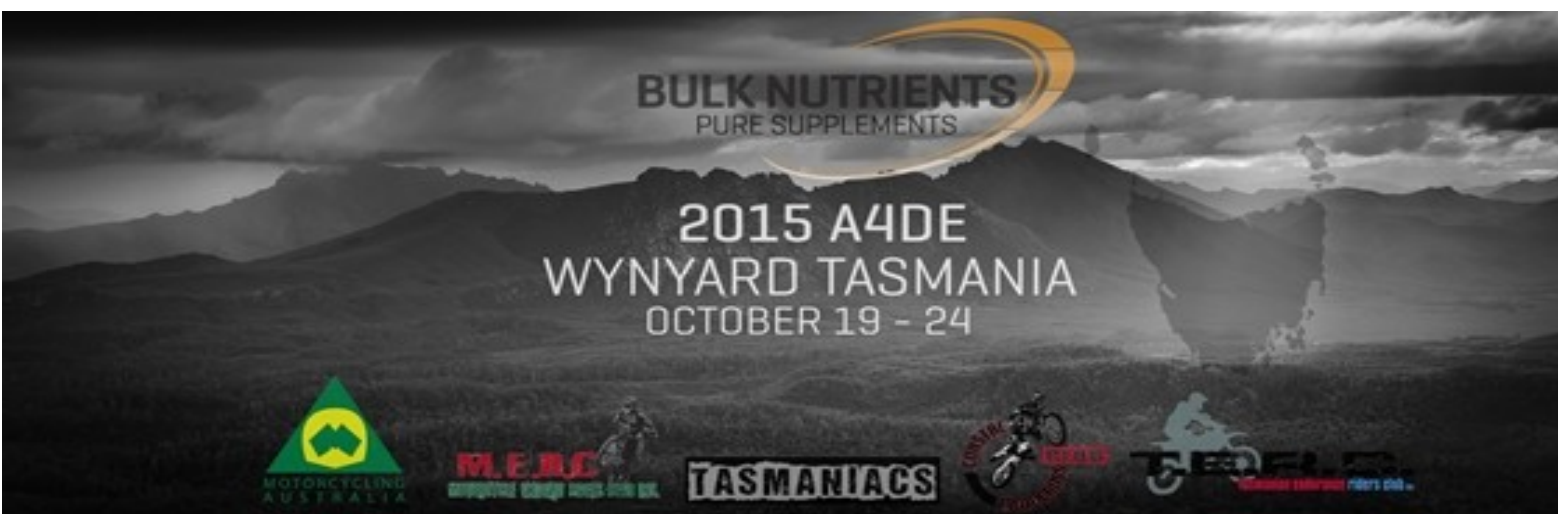

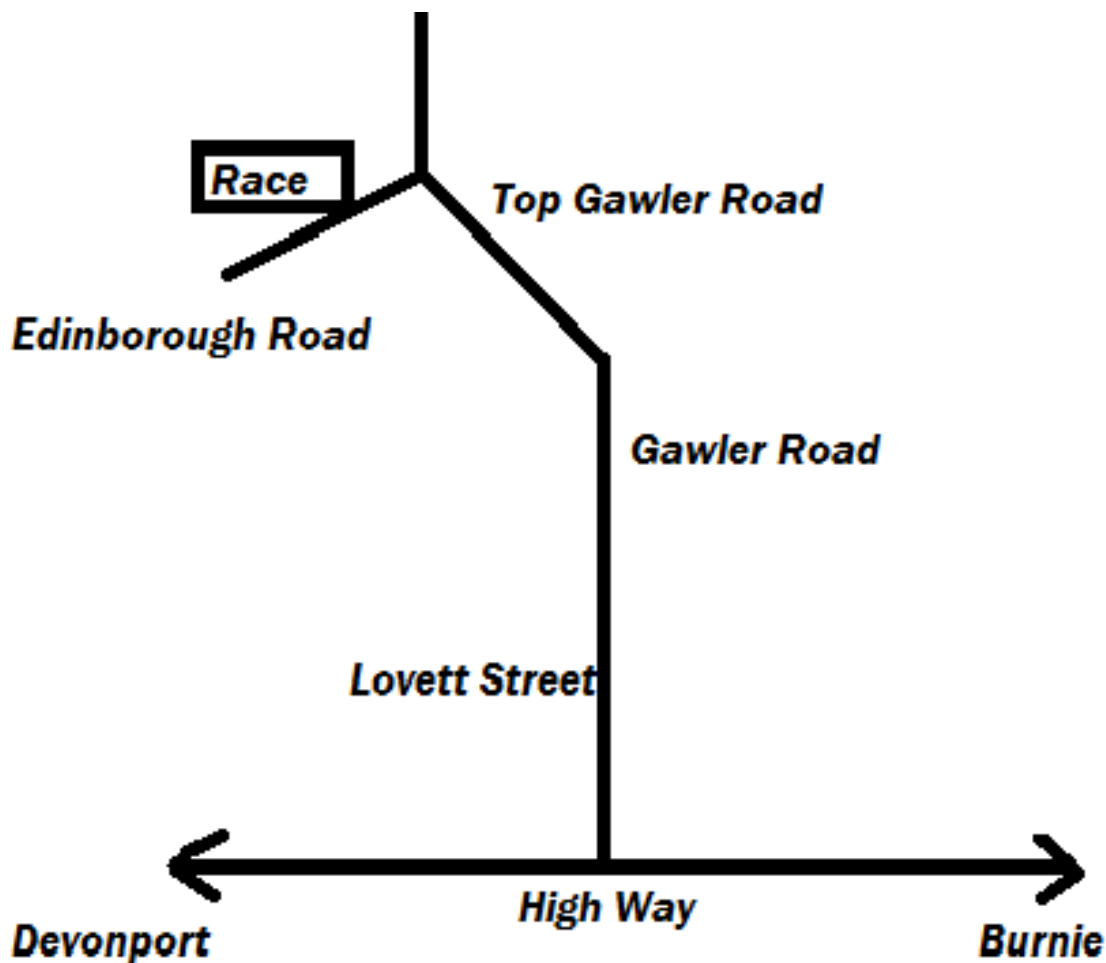
Committee Meetings
