Just a reminder that your transponder needs charging a couple of days before the next race otherwise your bike won't register on the timing system.

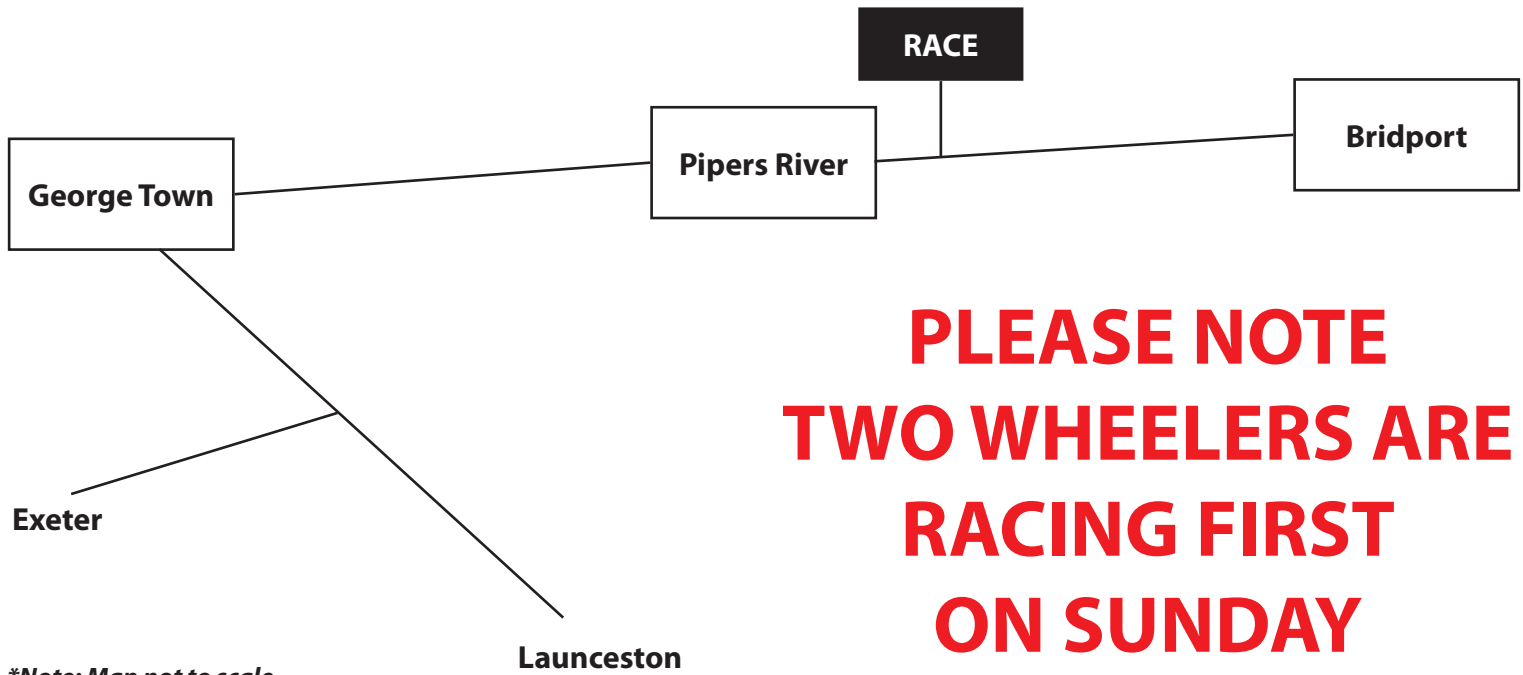
Lost Property
