Lost Property

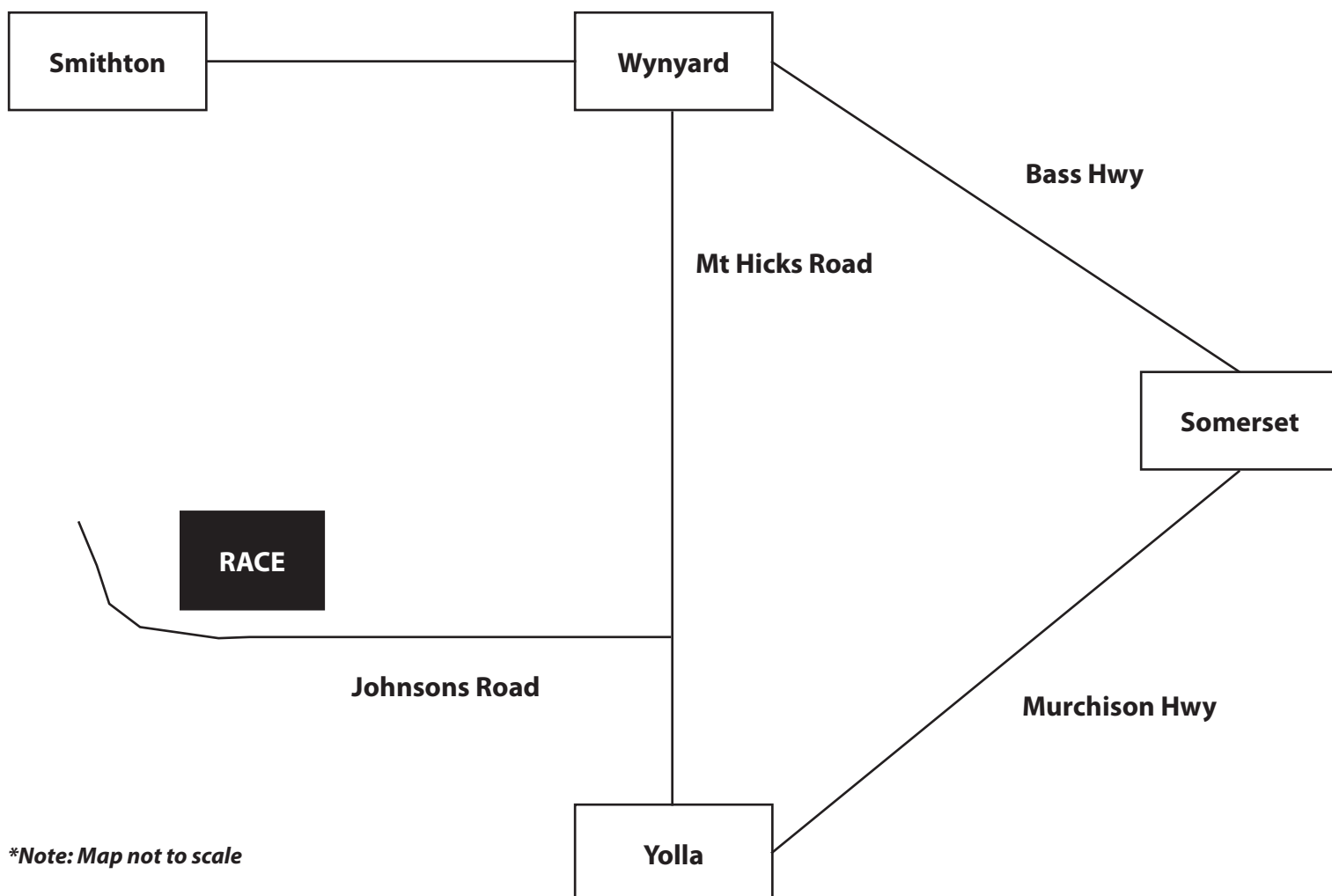
Have you lost something? Check at the van at the next race.
